Lous Seurrots is committed to you, to all of us, to sustainable tourism. Certified with the European Ecolabel, our estate takes concrete action to preserve the Landes forest, water, energy and biodiversity. Staying with us means choosing responsible holidays!

Our Concrete Actions



1. Responsible Resource Management

Reducing electricity consumption

- 100% of our electricity is produced from renewable energy sources
- Energy efficiency monitoring and control of our consumption
- Low-energy lighting throughout the site
- Swimming pools heated with new high-performance heat pumps

Sustainable water management

- Our sanitary facilities and accommodations are equipped with water-saving devices
- No daily replacement of bed linen during stays, in order to save water

- 90% of our maintenance products are eco-labelled or environmentally certified
- Thermal weeding of green areas

- Protection of the large pine trees present on the site

Our Eco-Friendly Actions



1. Buying Local is Ideal!

On the menu, I choose local and seasonal products and limit my consumption of animal protein. The Lous Restaurant, local markets and the Lanes farm are my best allies! I extend the pleasure by bringing home souvenirs from local and responsible producers. You can find these products at the Reception Shop.

2. With Sorting, Choose the Right Colours for Your Holiday!

I sort my waste according to the guidelines at my holiday destination: yellow, green, brown - each waste item has its colour! Recycling points are available in the parking area at the entrance of Lous Seurrots. At the restaurant or for a snack, no food waste! I serve myself according to my appetite and, if necessary, ask for a doggy bag. I sort my waste instead of throwing everything away. For shopping, picnics on the beach or in the forest, I prefer reusable containers. Packaging, cigarette butts, chewing gum... I take a small bag with me to collect them and dispose of them properly.



3. Use Less Water - Every Drop Counts!

I choose a short, lukewarm shower (max. 4 minutes). I turn off the water while washing my hands and brushing my teeth. If they are still clean, I keep my sheets and towels for several days. I use eco-labelled cosmetic and cleaning products. If I notice a water leak, I inform the reception.



4. Meaningful Experiences, Gentle Immersion

I favour non-motorised activities that respect wildlife and nature. I stay on marked trails to avoid trampling and erosion of fragile protected areas. I use environmentally friendly sunscreen.



5. Take Your Time: Walk, Cycle or Use Public Transport!

For short trips, I enjoy a gentle walk or a bike ride to discover the hidden gems of the area. I rent my bike from our partner Ebikes & Co, located at the entrance of the Domaine. If the distance is longer, I take the free town-beach shuttles operated by CLNT, with line 12 connecting Contis to Cap de l'Homy.

6. Brighten Your Holiday While Saving Energy!

I switch off the lights when leaving a room. I turn off appliances on standby and unplug chargers before going to bed. In summer, I air out my accommodation during the coolest hours to keep it fresh. I use the eco programs on washing machines and dishwashers and run them only when full. If I need heating, I set it to 19°C, the ideal balance between comfort and energy savings.



7. Consume Responsibly - But How?

Lodge tents, chalets and cottages are available from 5 p.m. on the day of arrival.



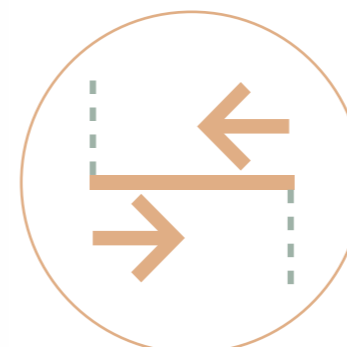
Tent, caravan and motorhome pitches are available from 2 p.m. on the day of arrival.

Notre Histoire

L'histoire de cette hôtellerie se conjugue avec celle de la famille de Lur Saluces, du domaine d'Uza, voisin dans les Landes, et du Château de Fargues, en Gironde.

Dès la fin des années 1930, dans un contexte de développement du camping de masse (avec l'apparition des congés payés en 1936), le directeur du Domaine d'Uza accorde, avec l'autorisation du marquis de Lur Saluces, un emplacement sur la côte: « en bout de propriété à Contis », à une colonie de vacances pour le mois d'août 1937.

En juillet 1963, le camping est classé en 1ère catégorie, pouvant accueillir 350 campeurs.

Après un agrandissement vers l'océan, avec un succès et des demandes toujours en hausse, Lous Seurrots ne cesse de s'étendre et de réaliser des travaux d'aménagement pour accueillir plus de touristes.

Le camping obtient 3 étoiles en 1978, 4 étoiles en 1997 et sa cinquième étoile en 2017.

LE SAVIEZ-VOUS ?

Lous Seurrots signifie « *le petit camping* » en vieux Gascon.

En mai 1961, un arrêté préfectoral autorise l'ouverture du « terrain de camping Lous Seurrots »

Le Lous Seurrots s'étend sur *la lande* au cœur d'une forêt de pins maritimes.

● Campsite rules

1. UPON ARRIVAL

Park in the external car park and go to reception to check in. You will be given identification wristbands and all the information relating to your stay. We will ask for your vehicle registration number so that you can enter the campsite. Wearing the wristband is mandatory for the entire duration of your stay. Staying on the campsite implies acceptance of these rules and the commitment to comply with them. Any person wishing to stay at least one night must first report to reception to complete the formalities. Please also declare any visitors at reception.

2. SETTING UP YOUR PITCH

Your equipment and vehicle must be installed on the pitch indicated by the campsite staff.

3. SPEED LIMIT

The speed limit inside the campsite is 10 km/h. Traffic between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. is prohibited. During this time, vehicles must remain parked in the external car park. Parking is prohibited on roads and on pitches other than your own.

4. IF YOU WISH TO EXTEND YOUR STAY

This depends on availability. Please inform reception at least 24 hours before your departure.

5. RESPECT YOUR NEIGHBOURS

Please be courteous and avoid noise, games or discussions that may disturb others. Lower the volume of radios and televisions. Using car horns inside the campsite is prohibited.

6. RESPECT CLEANLINESS

Please keep your pitch, accommodation and the campsite clean. All waste must be placed in the designated containers.

7. RESPECT OUR STAFF

Please show respect for all our staff and for the work carried out to maintain the facilities, especially the sanitary blocks. Guests must refrain from any behaviour that could damage the cleanliness or hygiene of the campsite facilities. During your stay, please keep your pitch tidy and clean, as well as shared facilities such as the sanitary blocks. Children must always be accompanied to the sanitary facilities.

8. RESPECT NATURE

Please respect trees, plants, fences and campsite facilities. It is strictly forbidden to hammer nails into trees or cut branches. Any damage caused within the campsite will be charged to the person responsible.

9. PLAY AREAS

Children must always remain under the supervision of their parents.

10. SWIMMING POOL

The swimming pool is strictly reserved for campsite guests. Please follow the hygiene and safety instructions displayed at the pool.

11. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

Drying laundry inside sanitary blocks is prohibited, but it may be done discreetly on your pitch. It is also forbidden to stretch lines between two trees as this may be dangerous. Smoking or vaping is not allowed inside the accommodations.

12. PETS

Only one domestic pet is allowed per pitch or accommodation. Category 1 and 2 dogs are not permitted on the campsite. Your pet must be vaccinated against rabies and its vaccination record must be available at reception if requested. Pets must be kept on a lead and must not be left alone to avoid disturbing neighbours. Pets are not allowed in the swimming pool area or sanitary facilities. Please clean up after your pet (waste bags are available near reception). Management reserves the right to ask any guest who does not respect these rules to leave the campsite.

13. SAVE WATER

Water must not be used for washing vehicles.

14. DEPARTURE

Pitches must be vacated before 12 noon. Rental accommodations must be vacated before 10 a.m. (or 2 p.m. for late departure options, subject to availability, except July-August and special weekends - €30). Accommodation must be returned perfectly clean. Otherwise, a cleaning fee will be charged. Items forgotten in sanitary blocks or accommodations will not be returned by the campsite.

15. THEFT

Management cannot be held responsible for theft within the campsite. Please report any suspicious person immediately to reception or the security staff. Although surveillance is provided, guests are advised to take normal precautions to safeguard their belongings.

16. UNACCOMPANIED MINORS

No minor may stay at the campsite without a parent or legal guardian.

17. BREACH OF THE SITE RULES

If a guest disturbs the stay of others or fails to comply with these rules, management or its representative may request them, verbally or in writing, to stop the disturbance. In case of serious or repeated breaches of the site rules, and after being asked to comply, management reserves the right to terminate the guest's stay.

● Safety Instructions Fire - Flood - Storm

1. FACILITATE EMERGENCY RESPONSE

- Identify emergency exits and the routes leading to them.

- Call emergency services by dialing 112 or inform campsite management.
- Turn off the gas outside and cut the electricity supply.
- Leave your vehicle and camping equipment in place.
- Do not take shelter inside your caravan in case of severe flooding or coastal storms (it may be swept away).
- Head to the nearest emergency exit.

DIAL 112 FOR ALL EMERGENCIES



Near all village facilities you will find the evacuation plan in case of fire, storm or flood alert. Identify your evacuation route to the nearest emergency exit in advance. If you hear the alarm signal, evacuate the area immediately.
